

SUBMISSION PROCESS

Section 14 of General Guidelines apply

No additional obligatory submission process required by the IF, section 14 of the General Guidelines applies.

O1 ATHLETE

Identification of the Manufacturer

Clothing

· Competition clothing/Warm-up & Training suits One Identification of the Manufacturer per clothing item will be permitted, to a maximum size of 30cm². One Identification of the Manufacturer will be permitted on Zippers and Buttons and should appear in the same colour as the concerned item (I.e. tone on tone), as long as such identifications are deemed not conspicuous by the IOC.

One-piece bodysuit

One Identification of the Manufacturer [] shall be permitted above the waist and below the waist, in accordance with the maximum sizes noted above: however, these identifications shall not be placed immediately adjacent to each other.

Collars and roll necks

If a roll neck or polo shirt is worn, no identification of the manufacturer may appear on the collar or on the neck. Only one Identification of the Manufacturer will be allowed; it may be situated on the chest, with a maximum size of 30cm2.

Socks | Gloves

Please refer to general principles.

Headgear / caps, beanies

One Identification of the Manufacturer per Item. with a maximum size of 10cm² or two Identifications of the Manufacturer per accessory item will be permitted, with a maximum size of 5cm² each and placed above each ear.

May carry the Identification of the manufacturer retail trade during the period of 6 months or more prior to the Winter Youth Olympic Games, with the identifications permitted on the lenses so long as such identifications are engraved into the lens and

Helmet

May carry the Identification of the Manufacturer [] as generally used on products sold through speciality shops during the period of 6 months or more prior to the Games. No aerodynamic elements may be attached to the helmet.

All General Principles apply unless expressly mentioned otherwise hereafter (in particular in relation to size, frequency or location). Please refer to the "Identifications on NOC Team Apparel Practical Guidelines", and General Guidelines (released Summer 2023) to obtain the general principles of Authorised Identifications on NOC uniforms at the

Goggles / Plexiglass / Visors

May carry the Identification of the Manufacturer as displayed on products sold through the retail consumer market at least six (6) months before the Winter Youth Olympic Games, with the identifications permitted on the lenses (e.g. goggles, plexiglass, visors) so long as such identifications are engraved into the lens and are not deemed as conspicuous by the IOC.

Race Gloves

One Identification of the Manufacturer [per accessory item will be permitted, and may be split to two parts, with a maximum size of 15cm² per glove.

Accessories

Bag

One Identification of the Manufacturer per bag will be permitted, covering no more than 10% of the surface, to a maximum size of 60cm2.

Shoes / Footwear

Shoes All footwear items may carry the Identification of the Manufacturer as generally used on products sold through the retail trade during the period of 6 months before the Winter Youth Olympic Games.

Product Technology Identification

Clothing

· Competition clothing/ Warm-up & Training suits

One additional Product Technology Identification will be permitted per clothing item, to a maximum size of 10cm².

· One-piece bodysuit

One Product Technology Identification [•] shall be permitted above the waist and below the waist, in accordance with the maximum sizes noted above; however, these identifications shall not be placed immediately adjacent to each other.

Additional IF Specifications

Section 05

Third Party Identifications (Athletes names)

The athletes name may be displayed twice on the back of the helmet and the height of the writing shall not exceed 15mm.

Athletes may also have their names on their Steel protectors to allow for easy identification during the Winter Youth Olympic Games.

Section 07

NOC Emblems and National Identity (National flags / emblems / codes)

No IF Specific regulations with regards to National Identifications, section 07 of the General Guidelines applies.

Helmets

The national flag and/or NOC [•] emblem is permitted to on the helmet to a max 30cm2.

Identification of the Manufacturer

Sport Equipment

Sled/Pod

Two Identifications of the Manufacturer [] per each side of the pod. In any case, the total identification area shall not cover more than 10% of the sled surface, to a maximum size of 60cm² on each side of the pod, and so long as the manufacturer is deemed a sports brand.

Sled/Runners

One floating Identification of the Manufacturer [per runner. In any case, the total identification area shall not cover more than 10% of the runners surface, to a maximum size of 60cm2 on each runner, and so long as the manufacturer is deemed a sports brand.
